

Pupil Support Team - Policy and Procedure

Policy

The Pupil Support Team (PST) has been put into place in order to give all children at Nant-y-Cwm (NYC) Steiner School further opportunities to share their thoughts and opinions and to play an active role in the decisions that affect their learning and well-being at NYC school.

Procedure

The team will:

- Be formed of children from classes 6,7,and 8, who will make a termly commitment to meet weekly in either break or lunch times.
- Include a member of the teaching team.
- Have a facilitator and note taker.
- Use the meeting form in common with all school teams.
- Use the decision making tool in common with all school teams.
- Form a team plan in common with all school teams, that will help form part of the School Development Plan.
- Make themselves known to all pupils of the school, through an information sheet on the notice board, verbal communication and school assemblies.
- Meet with other teams when necessary.
- Maintain confidentiality when necessary.
- Hold themselves as an exemplary peer group at all times.
- Uphold the school rules and help other pupils whenever prudent.
