

Pupil Support Team - Policy and Procedure

Policy

The Pupil Support Team (PST) aim is to give all children at Nant-y-Cwm (NYC) Steiner School further opportunities to share their thoughts and opinions and to play an active role in the decisions that affect their learning and well –being at NYC school.

Procedure

The team will:

- Be formed of children from classes 6, 7, and 8, who will make a termly commitment to meet weekly in either break or lunch times.
- Include a member of the teaching team.
- Have a facilitator and note taker.
- Use the meeting form in common with all school teams.
- Use the decision making tool in common with all school teams.
- Form a team plan in common with all school teams, that will help form part of the School Development Plan.
- Make themselves known to all pupils of the school, through an information sheet on the notice board, verbal communication and school assemblies.
- Meet with other teams when necessary.
- Maintain confidentiality when necessary.
- Hold themselves as an exemplary peer group at all times.
- Uphold the school rules and help other pupils whenever prudent.
